5. If you were making a movie of this book, who would you cast as Kerryl? Who as Lander?
6. Have you read any other books by Phill Featherstone? If so, how did they compare with this book? If you got the chance to ask Phill one question, what would it be?
7. What feelings did this book evoke for you?
8. How important is the location of the story? Were you able to get a picture of the farm? the landscape? Walbrough?
9. There are several deaths in this book. Did any of them move you?
10. The second book in the REBOOT series, After Shocks, tells the story of Lander? What do you think happened to him?
11. What do you think of the book's title? How does it relate to the book's contents? What other title might you choose?
12. What do you think of the book's cover? How well does it convey what the book is about?
13. What do you think the author's purpose was in writing this book? What ideas was he or she trying to get across?
14. If you could hear this same story from another person's point of view, who would you choose?
